## SALT IS NOT GOOD FOR YOU (OR YOUR CAR)

Most of us have noticed some changes in how the roads have been taken care of in the Winter. Roads used to be sanded, but many places have gone to using just salt (Sodium Chloride). One of the big reasons for this is that by using just salt, the storm sewers don't have to deal with all the sand, which can take a lot of labor(\$\$) to clear out. Salt just dissolves in rain water.

A more recent change in Minnesota is the use of a pre-coating to be put on the roads when a snow storm is expected. As the snow falls, and it is run over by traffic, especially heavy trucks, it is rolled into ice. If the road is pre-coated, the ice breaks loose and can be removed by the plow. This eliminates the need to keep spreading salt and subsequent plowing. The popular pre-coating chemical is Magnesium Chloride, in liquid form.

I stopped by the Public Works Department of Edina to see what they are using. They have gone to salt without sand, with some Magnesium Chloride added. I had thought that the green stuff on the road I was seeing was rumored to be some form of rust inhibitor, but that is not the case. It is the Magnesium Chloride with a dye added to aid in determining if the mix is

correct. The Public Works guy told me that everyone is using the same stuff, as it is bid by the State (!).

Salt is hard on cars because it makes water more conductive, which is what promotes corrosion in metals. Pure salt dries out and then it is not such a problem, until it gets wet again. Magnesium Chloride is much worse, as it doesn't dry because it can absorb water out of relatively dry air. When it is used, you will note that it doesn't dry on the road. It also is extremely corrosive to Aluminum. Truckers out west noticed this years ago when the Aluminum shoes in the trailer drum brakes corroded to the point that it pushed the lining off the shoes and jammed the drums. Nearby power pole insulators can be shorted out by the stuff too. One of the first places to notice corrosion on your car is on the brake rotors if the car is not driven daily. There will be a slight grinding noise on the first stop or so.

What can you do for your car? Wash frequently in salty conditions is obvious. Unfortunately it doesn't work as good as one might imagine. When I went through the "Mudblaster Underbody Wash", and it didn't take off even the most minimal crud. I ended up using the garden hose, paying

particular attention to the fender lips. The trucker recommendation is to drive fast through a heavy rain in the spring.

Something else to try to avoid is the dust control coating on gravel roads. While not as aggressive as the Magnesium Chloride, the Calcium Chloride also absorbs moisture and stays wet (that is how it controls dust).
